Dear Laker Families,

We promised some additional details about in-person learning for the upcoming year and here it is! This is not an all-inclusive list, but an overview of the big things you've been wondering and asking about.

An average day for a Laker student in Phase 4...

- **Riding the Bus**
  - Masks must be worn by all students K-12.
  - Temps will be taken by the driver as students board the bus.
  - Students with high temps will be seated in the front and referred to our clinics upon arrival at school (our Scheurer school clinics will have expanded hours this year).
- **Parent Drop-Off**
  - School doors will remain closed until 7:30AM, at which time parents may drop students off at the curb (in masks) or walk them to the front door of the building. Parents will no longer be able to walk students inside.
- **Breakfast**
  - K-5 students will be served in their classrooms.
  - 6-12 students may eat in the cafeteria with social distancing.
- **Hallway Transitions**
  - All students must wear masks, observe right side/left side traffic flow.
- **In Class**
  - K-5 in classroom cohorts, no masks.
  - 6-12 masks required in classrooms, can remove if class is outdoors.
  - PE/Band/Music procedures will be announced later, with an emphasis on outdoor activity with social distancing (no masks) whenever possible.
- **Lunch**
  - K-5 students will get food and return to classrooms.
  - 6-12 students will get food and return to their prior classroom to eat, then will be released to common areas for free time with masks and/or social distancing.
- **Disinfecting**
  - All students will have access to sanitizer stations, courtesy of Scheurer Health.
  - Common areas will be disinfected by custodial staff 4x per day.
  - 6-12 students will wipe desks/tables/chairs before leaving each class period.
  - All facilities and buses will be disinfected with mist/fog spray each night.
- **Masks**
  - Students should bring their own masks from home each day.
  - The district will have disposable masks available for any student or parent who forgets their own mask or enters the building without one.

We hope this helps as you make plans and decisions for your children's learning this fall. If you have additional questions, please feel free to contact your building office or stay tuned for more updates from the district. We know that none of these things are ideal, but we'll do our best to make the best of it!
