

Selection Criteria for the Gordon W. & Loyse B. Hueschen Science Scholarship

- Acceptance at Michigan State University (MSU) in a qualifying science curriculum (MSU sends us the list of eligible applicants).
- Grade Point Average (Science G.P.A. & Math G.P.A.)
- SAT Scores
- Science Honors and Awards
- Listing of Science Courses Taken (5 point)
- Difficulty of All Courses Taken

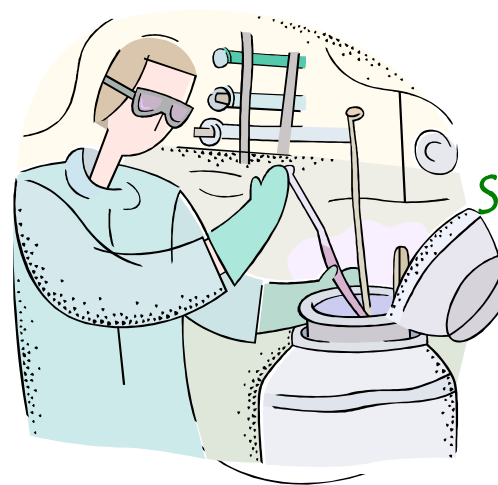
On the basis of the above mentioned, semi-finalists will be selected.

- Semi-finalists will write a 300 word essay. An example topic would be: How do I plan to influence the science world?
- Semi-finalists will be interviewed at a designated time and place.

The Award

The Gordon W. and Loyse B. Hueschen Science Program Scholarship shall be awarded once annually. Selection of the recipient will be made during the spring semester with the announcement to be made at or before the Laker Graduation Exercises.

The award shall be for tuition, fees, and room and board equal to the cost for a full meal plan in a "double" University residence hall room.

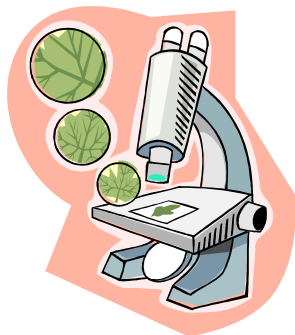
Each Gordon W. and Loyse B. Hueschen Science Program Scholarship shall be renewable for up to a four year term provided the recipient maintains appropriate academic standing in a qualifying science curriculum and appropriate progress toward a baccalaureate degree.

The Program

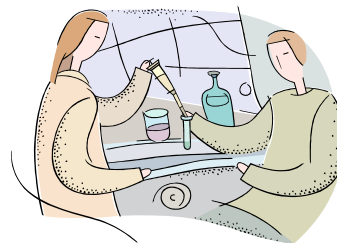
In 1993 Gordon W. and Loyse B. Hueschen entered into an agreement with Michigan State University to establish the Gordon W. and Loyse B. Hueschen Science Scholarship Program. A substantial gift by the Donor was intended to establish an endowed scholarship fund for the benefit of worthy and capable Laker High School students who become enrolled in Michigan State University.

Mr. Hueschen hoped that the Hueschen Science Scholarship Program would encourage students to make Michigan State University their big opportunity. As a young man he was encouraged to pursue "hard" science, which he found of inestimable value.

Mr. Hueschen wished the Gordon W. and Loyse B. Hueschen Scholarship Program would encourage other young men and women to pursue their baccalaureate degree in a "hard" science and make the "hard" sciences a foundation for their life's work.



Eligibility and Selection



Recipients of the scholarship shall be known as Gordon W. and Loyse B. Hueschen Science Scholars and will be selected according to the following criteria. The applicant must:

- Be a high school senior currently enrolled in Laker High School, who has submitted their application to Michigan State University into a school of science. Students must be regularly admitted to MSU by March 1st for the Fall Semester of the year following their graduation year.
- Be in good academic standing as determined by the Director, Office of Admissions and Scholarships, in consultation with the Laker High School Principal and faculty.
- Intend to pursue a four-year course of study within the colleges of Natural Science, Engineering, Nursing or Agriculture and Natural Resources to qualify, depending on the proposed course of study.
- Submit a letter of intent by October 1st to apply for the Hueschen Scholarship to the High School Guidance Office. This letter should highlight applicant's desire to pursue the study of science at Michigan State University.
