The Behavior Coordinator serves primarily to provide short-term support to students with our most challenging behaviors across school settings. Responsibilities include assisting staff with implementing accommodations, supporting positive behavior plans, modeling evidence-based interventions, and contributing to problem-solving teams within district and the HISD to address students' behavioral, emotional, and social needs. Other duties include maintaining student safety, collecting data, assisting with developing and adjusting behavior support plans, and participating in professional development opportunities. Additional tasks may involve presenting in small or large group settings, supporting students with aggressive behaviors, and other duties as assigned by the Principal(s).
